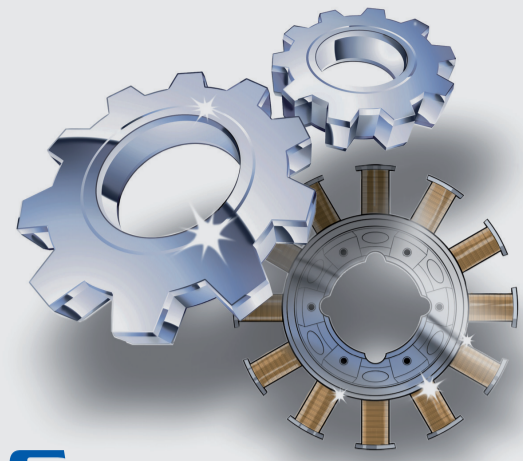

### **Conditions of entry and selection criteria**

The award is open to: BSc and MSc papers, theses and PhD theses that were completed after 1 November 2009, and which have been reviewed as 'excellent'. We welcome all topics that examine solutions and concepts relating to any aspect of transmission, drive and component development for vehicles (in all areas). The assessment criteria are: innovation, originality, and practical relevance for tomorrow's sustainable, efficient and cost-effective drive technology.

Please submit the following as an attachment by email:

- The short version of the paper (max. 2 pages and 4 images) describing the task and the solution, and explaining why the paper is innovative
- Proof of grading (confirmation by the examiner)
- A short CV and a color portrait photo
- Your full contact details
